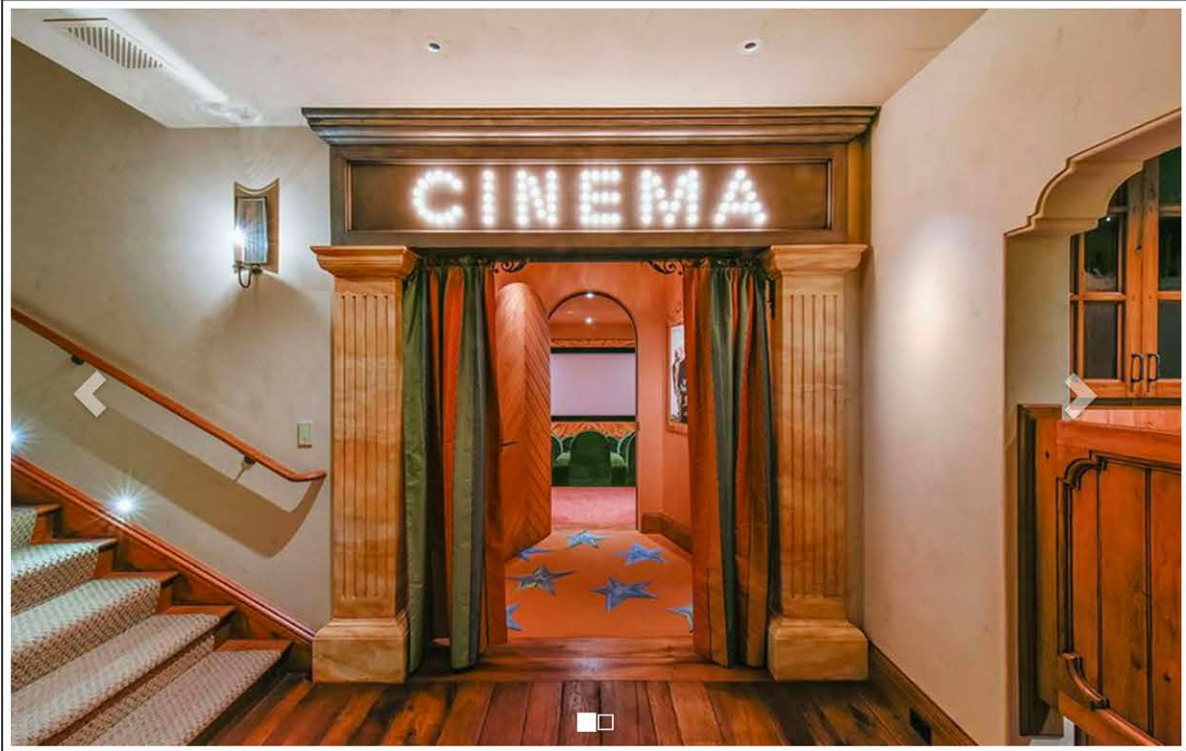

In addition to the main home, there's a detached 1,115 square-foot two-bedroom guest house and a 1,404 square-foot one-bedroom above the car barn.
